### National Doctor's Day 2022

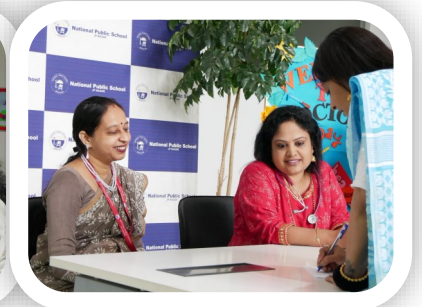

## Sense Organs

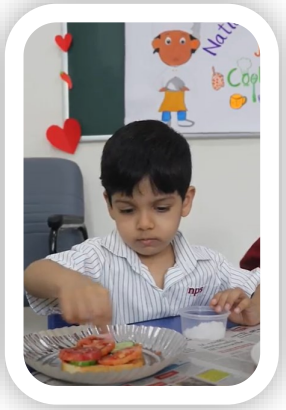
