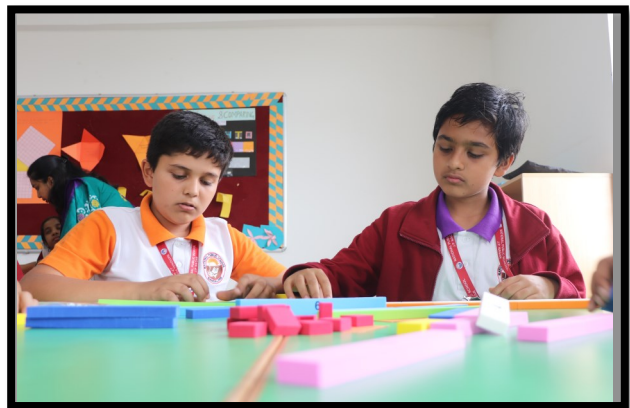
principles of our Constitution and the need to pre-

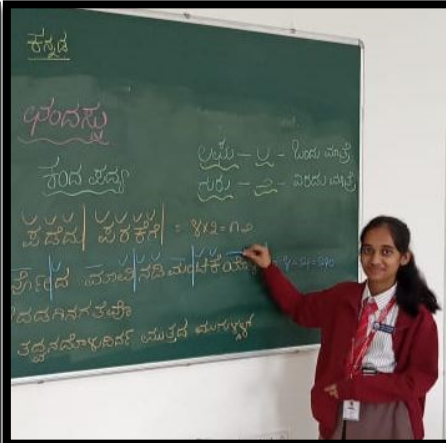


Classroom Activities
