and exchanged Christmas greetings and sang the Christmas carols.




#### **Classroom Activities**

#### Germination - 6th December, 2022

"Stay Green, Stay Positive ". Early childhood educators place a strong emphasis on teaching pupils how to be responsible citizens in addition to helping them grow academically. The Germination of Seeds exercise was carried out as a part of experiential learning with the intention of showing young children how plants grow from seeds. The teachers gave instructions on how

to plant seeds, hydrate them, and maintain them in a location where they will receive enough sun-

light. Every day, the kids were to check on the pot and report back to the teacher on the plant's development. The kids eagerly anticipated the appearance of the plant's shoot.
